

JOBSITE CHECKLIST FOR BLAZELOK® COATINGS

The following items are recommended for the application of Blazelok® water based fire
barrier coatings:
□ Personal Protection Equipment
☐ MSDS' for the coating and all solvents and other cleanup materials
☐ Disposable gloves
□ Correct spray tips – LTX 525 thru LTX 531(see Tech Data Sheet or material label)
☐ Airless sprayer with minimum .75 gallons per minute capacity (see Tech Data Sheet
for recommended spray equipment)
☐ Electrical power and appropriate gauge extension cord
☐ Fuel and oil for gas powered sprayers
☐ Clean, empty 5 gallon pails for screening the coating into
□ Door screen for screening paint
□ 30 mesh machine & gun (if applicable) filters
□ Power drill & mixer of appropriate size
Large cardboard sheets for prep, spray testing and cleanup
□ Drop cloths or poly sheeting
Clean metal flashing or equivalent for making Thickness Test Panels (See Demilec's
Coatings Thickness Memo)
□ Wet film gauge
☐ Electric heating pads as weather dictate (for 5 gal pails)
□ Portable fans to speed drying
☐ Space heaters as required to create conditioned space (≥ 60°f)
☐ Hand tools for hose leaks, etc
☐ Disposable paint brushes (plastic handles best to bend brush) for back brush areas
□ 90 degree swivels and paint wand extensions as required
□ Work lights as required
☐ Scaffolding, walk boards and safety rails as required ☐ Calinor for measuring the dried coating thickness on the Thickness Test Bandle
 Caliper for measuring the dried coating thickness on the Thickness Test Panels Permanent markers to mark the coating thickness on the Thickness Test Panels and
areas needing touchup
□ Clean-up rags
□ 2 five gallon pails for clean-up
☐ 5 gallons of water for clean-up, warm if available
☐ Dish detergent for clean-up 1-2 oz
☐ Antifreeze solution for final rinse and storage in sprayer
